## *Dear friends and supporters of Sudan Church Partners.*

In Exodus 3, God tells Moses *“I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their cry.”*

In 2020, God spoke to several of us about the suffering of His people in Sudan’s Nuba Mountains. This led to the founding of a volunteer-based non-profit called *Pax Dei for Nuba* (“God’s Peace in Nuba”). Our desire was to partner with Bishop Andudu and the Diocese of Kadugli in the Nuba Mountains. Like Moses, we didn’t really know what was in store, or how to proceed.

But God has been a faithful guide and champion of this work! Your support and the hard work of the leaders in Sudan have been used by God to re-establish Grace Christian School, with nearly 600 students, bring Christ-formed peace-building skills to a generation shaped by war, provide humanitarian support, and spread the good news of Christ the True King who will rule with justice, integrity, and love. Since 2020, you have provided \$990,000 to support this work!

May God bless you for your generosity!

In 2025, our organization changed our name to *Sudan Church Partners*. This change is more than cosmetic. It reflects our growing realization that God is working to impact the church across *all of Sudan*. It also reflects our role first and foremost as *partners* and co-laborers with the Sudanese Anglican Church, as opposed to being benefactors or overseers. Our Sudanese partners are wise, dedicated, and wholly committed to God’s Kingdom. Additionally, our name expresses that the church is the *primary vehicle* by which God will bring renewal to this region.

This year I was fortunate to join this mission as its first full-time Executive Director. This move by the Board of Directors was motivated by a deep commitment to establish a lasting institutional foundation for this work. I am delighted to join such a strong leadership team!

Lord willing, I will visit the Nuba Mountains in February and meet face-to-face with our partners there. As I learn and understand more deeply our important work, I feel blessed to be a part of the ways the Lord is using *Sudan Church Partners* for his kingdom.

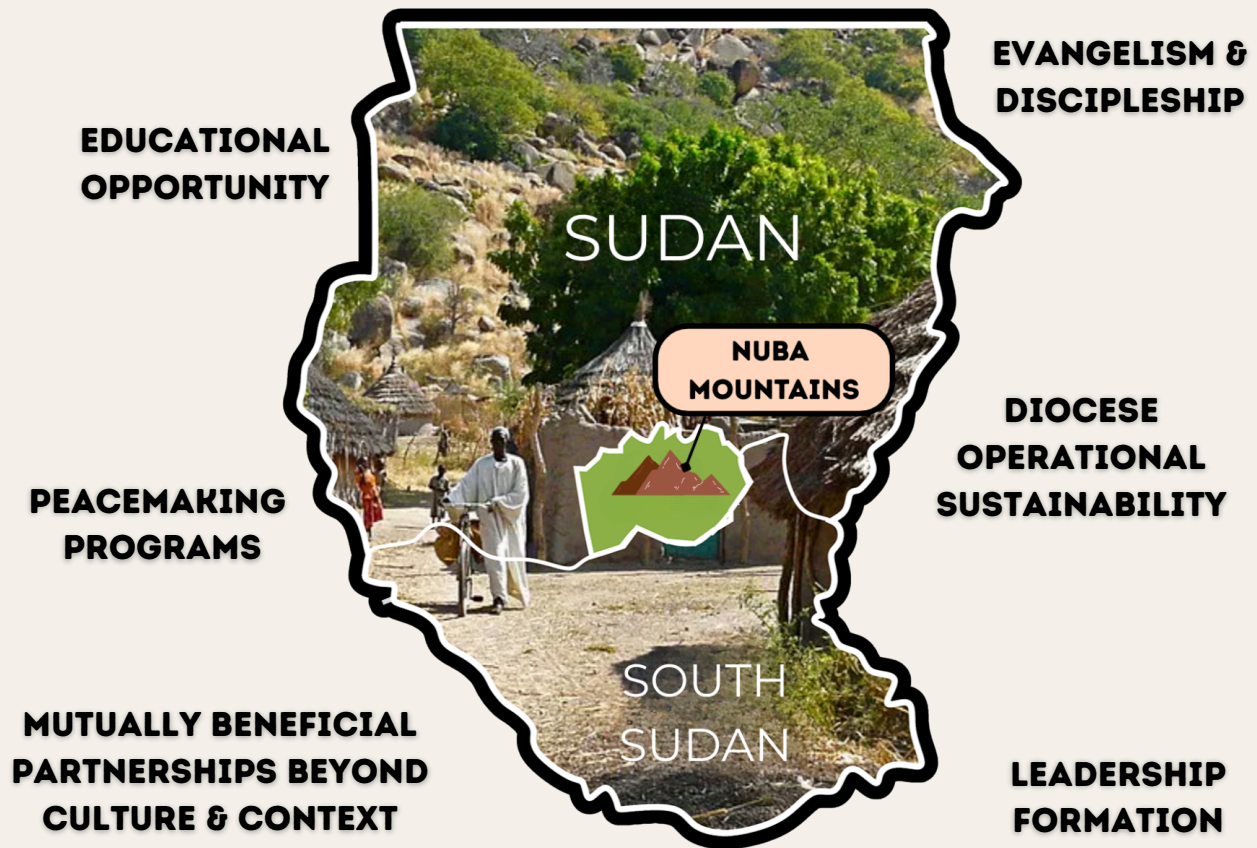

-Grace Secondary School's new campus is complete and attendance continues to grow. Our goal is to welcome new students while maintaining educational quality.

-Korkel Theological College is firmly established and operational under the leadership of Bishop Elsir Hassan Kuku of the newly planted Diocese of Heiban. The Alexandria School of Theology recently hosted a training for professors and has accredited Korkel's curriculum.

-In addition to primary, secondary, and theological schools, other educational programs are being offered, for example computer science.

-Bishop Andudu was awarded a PhD in November for his work on peace and reconciliation in Sudan

-Andudu and the diocese are the premier leaders in the Nuba Mountains for peace talks between conflicting tribes with high demand for more workshops

-Successful workshops inspired the local government to request more workshops on a larger scale. Even though the purpose of the workshops is not to evangelize, the quality and community impact are opening doors for the gospel.

# evangelism & discipleship highlights

-The Nuba Mountains contain great tribal diversity and this cultural complexity leads to a challenge in defining "reached" vs "unreached" areas. The Lord is opening doors in big ways in places like Tobo County where new relationships from recent peace workshops are bearing great fruit.

-It is always important to balance outreach events with development of leaders. Seeing the momentum and emotion of big events turn into day to day life and lived out faith is key, and we see that happening in Nuba where new leaders for various ministries are being formed and developed.

# diocese highlights



-The Diocese of Kadugli oversees many churches in the Western half and central area of the Nuba Mountains. Appropriate salaries for leaders are a challenge, but many are serving sacrificially. Future leaders are sent off to Uganda and other places to be educated and bring back their new skills to support the diocese.

-Parishes thrive in spite of scarce resources to support the diocese administration. This is vital, but without the outside support of SCP and other organizations from the USA, UK, and Australia, the diocese would not make such progress as war rages around them.
